2020 COVID Support by the Numbers

- \$454,927 in grants awarded to district businesses, with more on the way
- \$8,782 in PPE Kits and face mask bundles distributed
- 4 district sponsored Covid19 happy hours while that was possible to do safely
- \$6,552 of direct marketing for district business
- 34 hours participating in councils to align City policy with small business needs
- 5 businesses assisted in expanding outdoor dining


